## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

---

Atma Jaya Catholic University of Indonesia (AJCUI), is positioned at three campuses in Semanggi, Pluit, and BSD Campus. Semanggi Campus is located in the middle of Jakarta at the heart of Jakarta as the capital city of Indonesia. We called this campus by its vision as Center for Nation Development. In 2017, we initiated a center of public policy studies which we named as Atma Jaya Institute of Public Policy (AJIPP). This is in line with the vision of becoming strong partner to the nation in finding solutions of social and national problems through research and social engagement especially in public policy area.

This year, as part of the AJIPP we were very grateful in opening a library collection of significant figures who related to national public policy: **Ben & Nafsiah Mboi Collection (B&NC)**. The collection has more than 22,000 books and documents related to public policy, governmental and organizational management, socio-culture collection, health and medicine reference books, and Indonesia history especially Nusa Tenggara Timur area. Dr. Aloysius Benediktus Mboi M.P.H was the former Governor of Nusa Tenggara Timur (NTT) from 1978-1988. Ben Mboi started his career in two pathways: medicine and military. He was recognized as a brave person and change maker. Ben Mboi passed away on 23 June 2015 (80 years old) in Jakarta. His wife, Dr. Nafsiah Mboi, SpA, MPH was the former Ministry of Health (2012-2014) Nafsiah's involvement in the health sector began in 1978, when she, along with her husband, working in elevating the health and welfare of the people of Nusa Tenggara Timur. She is known to have a high concern in the field of HIV/AIDS advocacy. Mboi also pioneered the establishment of the Sentani Commitment in 2004 which became a milestone commitment of the governments for AIDS prevention. She is also known to be actively involved in the field of human rights and was the head of children's rights committee for the United Nations.

Ben & Nafsiah Mboi Collection is a place for researchers who keen to work on the collection; or on public policy, governmental management, and other possible field of study as Indonesianist. Within this early stage of establishing the collection, Atma Jaya Library (AtmaLib) looking for more volunteers to work with the collection. We have been working enthusiastically since January 2018. Within three months, we have just finished with 1,000 collections ready on the library shelf.

Therefore, the International Office and AtmaLib work together to offer **AJACollaB (Atma Jaya Academic Collaboration: Ben & Nafsiah Mboi Collection, an Inbound Researchers & Librarian Mobility)** to our universities partners, diaspora Indonesia, research bodies, libraries, and other field of network. This program will bring librarians and researchers at all level to **work together with AtmaLib in B&NC establishment, to study the collection in the areas related with researchers' area and Atma Jaya**. This program would bring not only experts but also students to not only working with the collection but also to experience **Indonesian culture, gain more understanding** among differences between culture through working together in the B&NC and at Atma Jaya. This activities will hopefully **help our students, faculty members, and university** to develop our best academic reputation. Moreover, experts will also have other chances to **share their experties toward** other universities within our **consortium** in the Association of Catholic University in Indonesia (APTIK). With this sharing chances, we believe that our **international experts will also develop their field and network**.

AJACollaB will provide:

- Airline ticket (round trip, economy class)
- Place to settle (around 2-4 km from Semanggi Campus)

- Meals (vouchers)
- Transportation (online transportation voucher)

## THE PROGRAM & REQUIREMENT

---

There will be two programs, you may choose one of them depending on your expertise and availability:

### 1. Summer program (May-August 2018)

The length of the program ranges from 6 weeks to 12 weeks, depending on your proposal. The program will focus on preparing the collection to be ready on the library shelves and to have at least bi-weekly book discussion to introduce the collection to the academic community. **This program will recruit students and librarians.** As we concern toward social engagement, we also encourage students and librarians to share knowledge and collaborate with our faculty member in this area.

The indicator of success of this program is having at least 80% of the collection ready on the library shelves and 8 events of biweekly book discussion. To achieve this indicator we will need 5-10 persons.

#### **Requirements:**

- Students: all majors with the passion in documentation or librarian studies
- Librarians: all major of librarian studies with at least Master level.
- Reputable university or research institutions
- Able to adapt to new situation and different culture
- Fill in the online application including proposed summer program weekly schedule (link of application: <https://tinyurl.com/AJACollaB>)
- Endorsement from the President or top manager level of the institution to apply to this program.

#### **Important dates:**

- Submit the proposal: before 30 April 2018
- Selection time periode: 30 April - 10 May 2018
- Announcement: 11 May 2018

### 2. Regular semester program (August-November 2018)

The length of the program ranges from 3 weeks to 12 weeks, depending on your proposal. The program may consist several activities with the focus on collaboration among experts, researchers, faculty members, students, and other scientific community.

Some example for the proposed collaborative activities are: doing research using Ben & Nafsiah Mboi Collection, team teaching on your expertise related to B&NC, team research relating to B&NC, writing publication together based on research using B&NC.

The indicator of success of this program is having at least one publication of collaborative report relating to B&NC.

#### **Requirements:**

- Master or Doctoral degree in the area of: public policy, health policy, literature, history, management, organizational or governmental management.
- Reputable university or research institution
- Able to adapt to new situation and different culture
- Fill in the online application including proposed program weekly schedule (link of application: <https://tinyurl.com/AIACollaB>)
- Endorsement from the President or top manager level of the institution to apply to this program.

- Submit the proposal: before 6 July 2018
- Selection time periode: 9 - 16 July 2018
- Announcement: 17 July 2018
